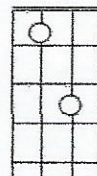


2. Let me be by myself in the evenin' breeze

Repeat 4 (slow at end) – F -C

Timing- 4/4:

ONE, 2+ 3+ 4+

ONE, 2+ 3+ 4+ etc...

Strum (nice and easy):

DOWN, Du, Du, Du

DOWN, Du, Du, Du, etc...

(D = downstroke,
u = flick back up)
