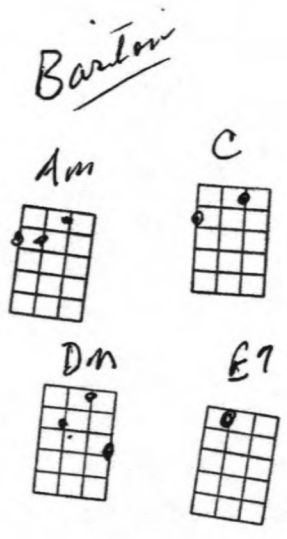
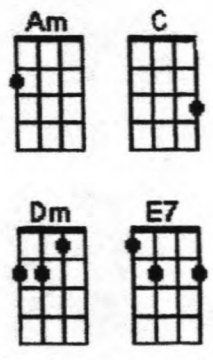


Summertime (v. II)
